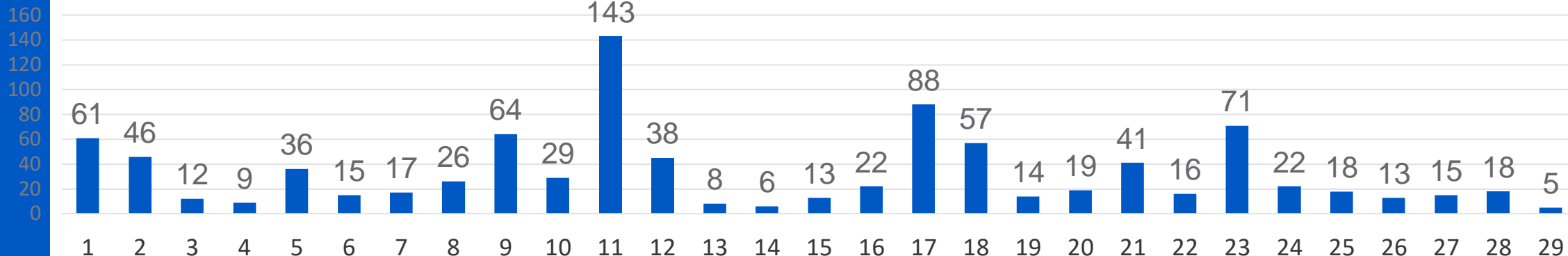


Higher education institutions in Latvia - 54

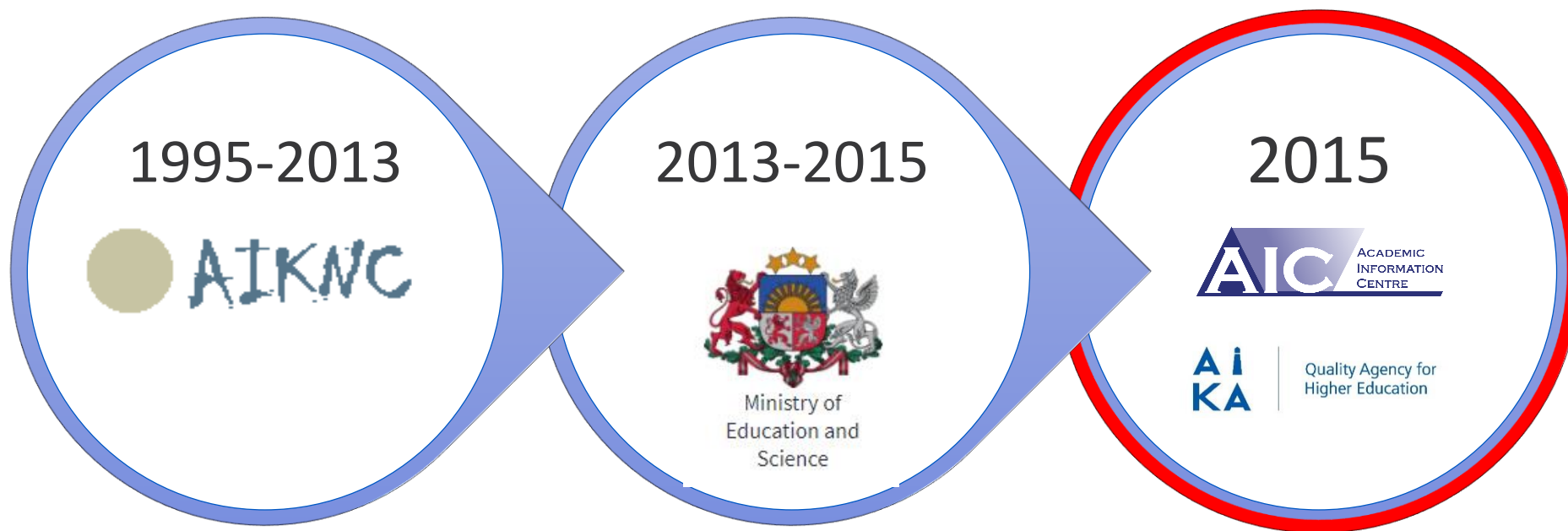

Academic Information Centre/ Quality Agency for Higher Education

- Defined by the Law on Higher Education Institutions as the institution responsible for organising accreditation processes
- Higher education system is open to any EQAR registered quality assurance agency (for one specific assessment procedure). However, the decision on accreditation is issued by AIC only.

Main functions of AIKA

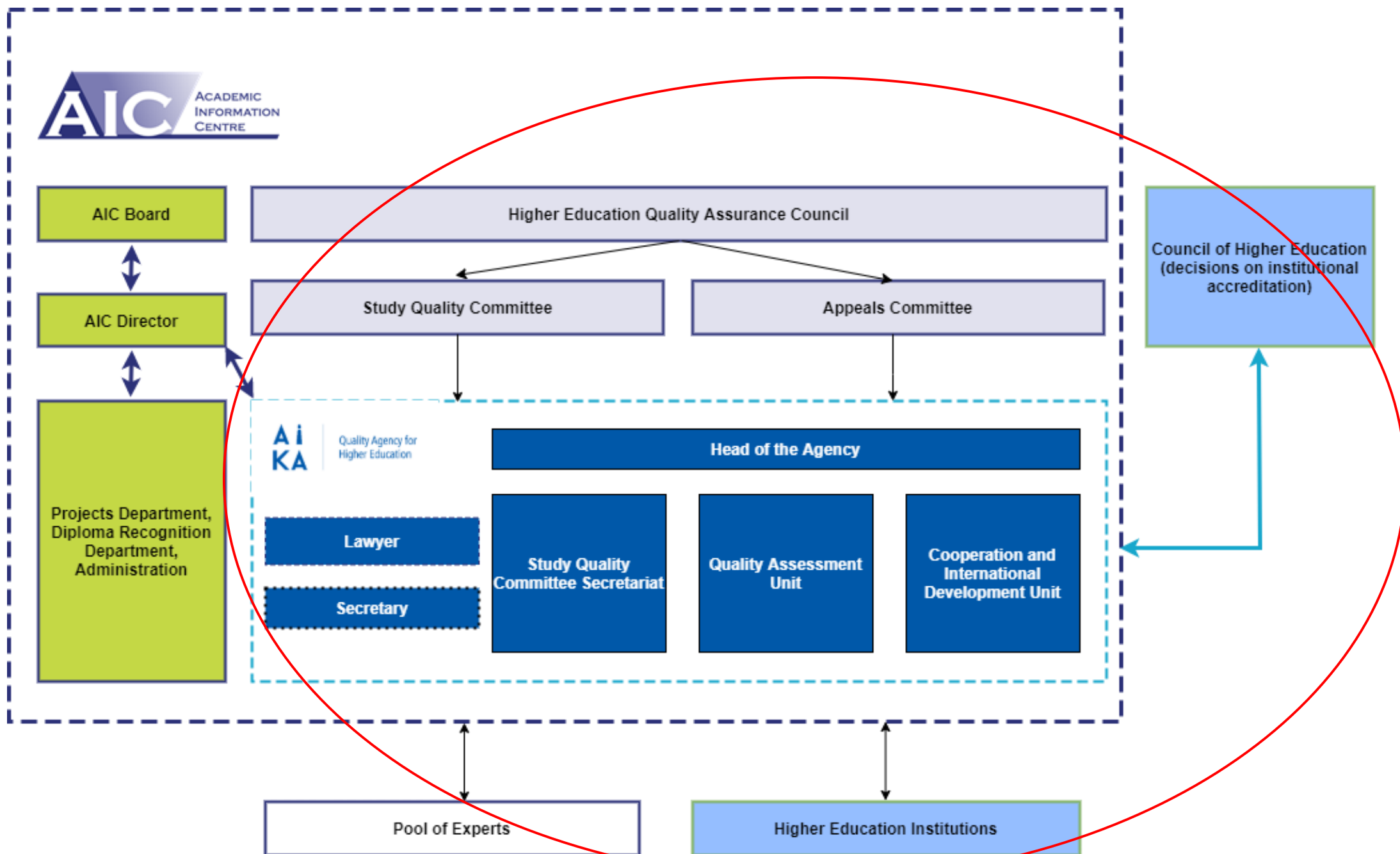
Ensure the accreditation of institutions of higher education and study fields, as well as licensing of study programmes.

Participate in international networks for external quality assurance.



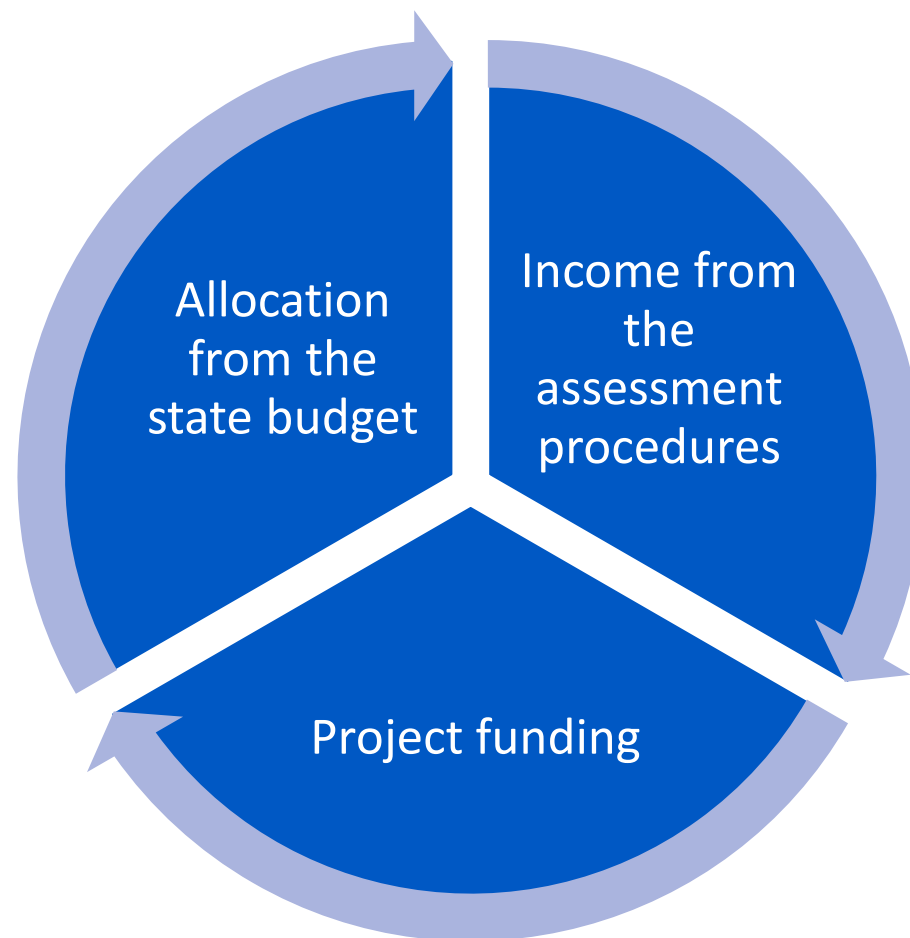

Quality Assessment Procedures

Licensing of a study programme

- non-cyclical procedure for each new study programme

Accreditation of a study field

cyclical procedure for a study field in each HEI, every 2 or 6 years

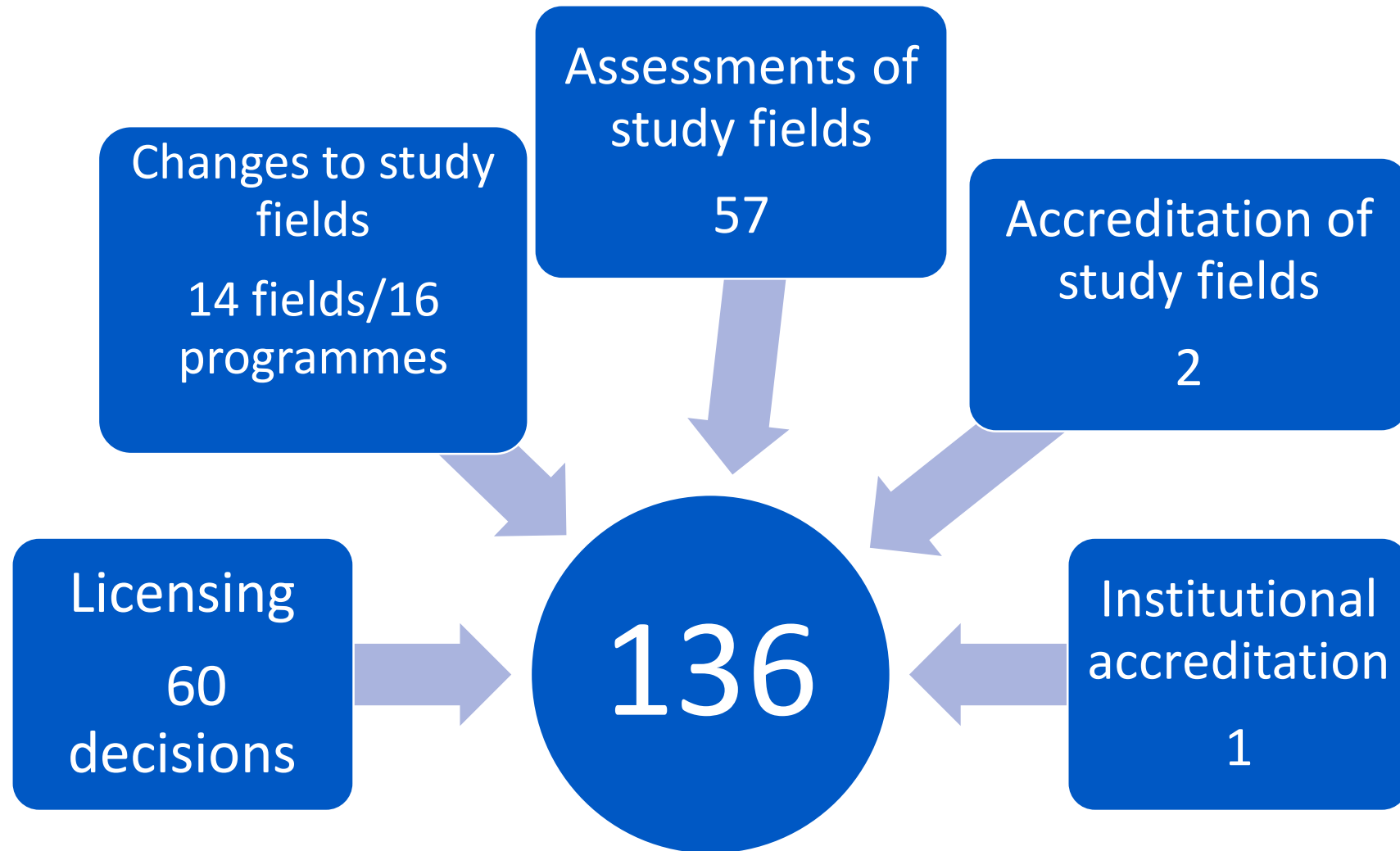
Accreditation of a higher education institution

- only once for each HEI shortly after the HEI has started operating

Assessment of substantial changes

- non-cyclical activity based on the request of HEIs

Guidelines	Detailed instructions for higher education institutions on preparation of SER and for experts on preparation of expert reports
Methodology	Detailed (step by step) instructions on the overall assessment process; schedule; tasks to be performed; duties and responsibilities
Cabinet Regulations/ Law on Higher Education Institutions	Overarching principles and regularity of the quality assurance processes, roles of those involved
